## ACCOMMODATION

Being a harbor and commercial capital of the country. one of the biggest constraints in Mumbai is accommodation. 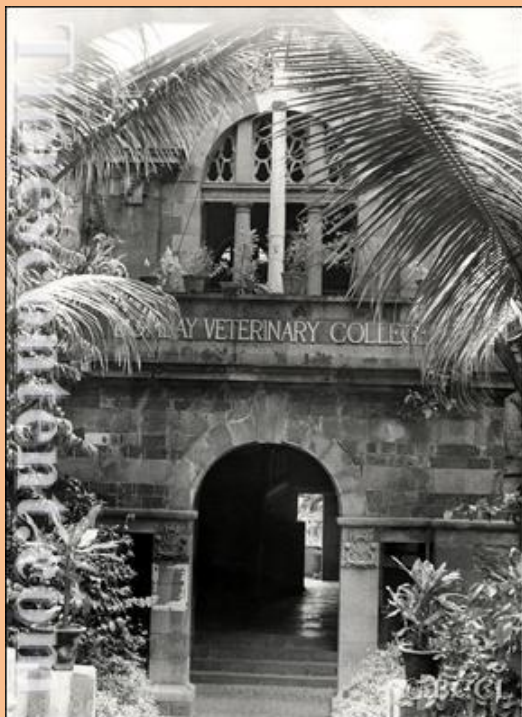

# CALL FOR ABSTRACTS

The abstract should be submitted in soft copy as a 'Microsoft word file' in Times New Roman, Font size 12, with single line spacing and 1" margin from all the sides. The abstract should be up to 250 words and the ones exceeding the



limit will be automatically rejected by the software system. The abstract should include the title, name of author(s) along with affiliations, key words of the research abstract, brief introduction, objectives, methodology, results and conclusion of the work. The authors can include good quality coloured photographs with suitable captions pertaining to the research which will be included as a part of compendium of symposium and poster presentation. Please underline the name of the presenting author along with the email address for communication. The authors are encouraged to use upper word limit and include colour photographs to make abstracts more elaborative and



meaningful for future reference work.

The acceptance will be informed electronically within a week after the receipt of the abstract. Accepted abstract will be included in the compendium only after the receipt of the registration fees by at least one of the authors.

All the delegates will receive compendium in the form of CD with registration kit.

## POSTER PRESENTATION

The size of the poster should not be more than 3'X3' and should depict title, name of the author(s), affiliations, key words of the abstract, objectives, materials and methods, results and conclusions. One large laminated poster sheet rather than small A4 sheets would be preferred.
